Timing & Travel

We'll depart on Friday, June 30, and arrive in London on Saturday, July 1. Students who attend the Honors Carolina orientation program on June 28 and 29 may stay on campus overnight on the 29th and depart from Raleigh-Durham International Airport on the 30th. The cost of overnight on-campus housing and transportation to the airport is included in the *London Calling!* program fee. Students who do not attend the Honors Carolina orientation program may depart from an airport of their choice. All participants will depart from London on Saturday, July 8.

Participants will make their own arrangements for air travel, departing on Friday, June 30, for arrival in London's Heathrow Airport on Saturday, July 1. Honors Carolina will assist students departing from Raleigh-Durham International Airport. Staff will greet arriving flights in London and arrange transport from the student flats to Heathrow airport

for their return to the United States on Saturday, July 8. We will share flight information for the faculty leaders and individual students who might wish to travel with other participants.

Cost & Registration

Thanks to generous support from Honors Carolina alumni, we can offer this London adventure for a deeply discounted price of \$1,850, which covers the cost of lodging, airport transfers, London Tube and bus transportation, museum and theater tickets, excursions, health insurance, and breakfast and dinner daily. **Airfare is not included in the program fee.**

Students interested in participating should [sign up here](#). In order for us to confirm your participation, we'll need to verify that you have:

- formally accepted your Honors Carolina invitation
- formally accepted admission to UNC and paid your enrollment deposit

Once confirmed, you will receive a follow-up email regarding payment procedures, passport requirements, and flight arrangements. Program participants will be billed via their UNC student account for the total \$1,850 program fee. A \$300 non-refundable deposit is due within two weeks of billing. The full balance is due by May 15.

Once 25 students have been confirmed, additional applicants will be wait listed.
