**June 29 (depart US) – July 7, 2019 (depart London)**

Travel to London with 23 other incoming first year Honors Carolina students. You'll spend the week at [Winston House](#), Honors Carolina's European study center located in the heart of London's historic Bloomsbury district, meet distinguished Honors Carolina alumni in a variety of fields, and get a taste of UNC's wide-ranging global connections.

### Timing & Travel

We'll depart on Saturday, June 29, and arrive in London on Sunday, June 30. Students who attend the Honors Carolina orientation program on June 27 and 28 may stay on campus overnight on the 28th and depart from Raleigh-Durham International Airport on the 29th. The cost of overnight on-campus housing and transportation to the airport is included in the *London Calling!* program fee. Students who do not attend the Honors Carolina orientation program may depart from an airport of their choice. All participants will depart from London on Sunday, July 7.

Participants will make their own arrangements for air travel, departing on Saturday, June 29, for arrival at London's Heathrow Airport no later than mid-day on Sunday, June 30. Honors Carolina will assist students departing from Raleigh-Durham International

Airport.

Staff will greet arriving flights in London and arrange transport from the student flats to Heathrow airport for their return to the United States on Sunday, July 7. We will share flight information for the faculty leaders and individual students who might wish to travel with other participants.

### **Cost & Registration**

Thanks to generous support from Honors Carolina alumni, we can offer this London adventure for a deeply discounted price of \$1,900, which covers the cost of lodging, airport transfers, London Tube and bus transportation, museum and theater tickets, excursions, health insurance, and breakfast and dinner daily. **Airfare is not included in the program fee.**

Students interested in participating should [sign up here](#). In order for us to confirm your participation, we'll need to verify that you have:

- formally accepted your Honors Carolina invitation
- formally accepted your UNC admission offer
- paid your UNC enrollment deposit (or have a waiver on file)

Once confirmed, you will receive a follow-up email regarding payment procedures, passport requirements, and flight arrangements. Program participants will be billed via their UNC student account for the total \$1,900 program fee. A \$300 non-refundable deposit is due within two weeks of billing. The full balance is due by May 31.

Once 23 students have been confirmed, additional applicants will be wait listed.
