



Michel David-Weill: Timeline

[The Michel David-Weill Scholarship](#) covers the cost of a two-year master’s program at Sciences Po in Paris, France for one American student every year. Sciences Po, an international research university, specializes in the social sciences and offers multidisciplinary programs taught in English and French. Although there is no restriction on the specific field of study at Sciences Po, students who are interested in pursuing an economics curriculum are strongly encouraged to apply, as this is Michel David-Weill’s field of expertise.

When to Apply: the Fall of your Senior Year

Action	Date
Check your eligibility on the The Michel David-Weill Scholarship website	Do this before beginning the application process
Work with ODS on your academic CV. Schedule an appointment with an ODS program assistant: https://calendly.com/ods-1 <i>This is not a required step, but students find these meetings helpful</i>	April - September
Send your recommenders your most current CV/resume. Follow our advice for creating an effective CV. Please also send recommenders this link to our “Advice for letter writers” page: https://honorscarolina.unc.edu/ods/resources-advice-for-letter-writers/	ASAP, but at least 1 month prior to mid-October endorsement deadline
Submit Recommenders Form : https://form.jotform.com/201524299115957	ASAP, but at least 1 month prior to mid-October endorsement deadline
Connect with Sciences Po faculty in the department to which you plan to apply: http://www.sciencespo.fr/en/education/graduate-studies <i>This is not required for the application process, but is highly recommended</i>	July-September
Draft application materials: Personal Statement, Recent Graded Research Paper (ideally from your chosen field of study)	June-September
For draft review, schedule an appointment with an ODS program assistant: https://calendly.com/ods-1 <i>Optional non-evaluative meeting with ODS team to talk about post-UNC plans and help frame your applications. Past scholars have found these helpful</i>	Early September



Send reminders to your recommenders that letters are due mid-October.	Suggested 6 & 4 weeks before endorsement deadline in mid-October
Upload ODS Application for UNC Endorsement Form before the endorsement deadline <i>Include your resume/CV, all relevant unofficial transcripts, recently graded research paper with comments, the candidate information form, and personal statement in one single PDF file</i>	Mid-October (exact deadline will be published on ODS site)
Interviews with UNC selection committee.	Mid-October
UNC nominee named.	End of October
UNC nominee revises their application. Schedule an appointment with ODS: https://calendly.com/ods-1	November
Notify your recommenders. Any letter revisions should be emailed to ods@unc.edu .	48 hrs. before deadline
Ensure ODS has final version of your complete application.	48 hrs. before deadline
ODS submits final application for you.	Foundation Deadline (late-November)
Candidates must submit a complete online application for Sciences Po master's program (with TCF or DALF French language test score for those pursuing a bilingual track or French track; no language score is required for English track).	Foundation Deadline (end of November)
Finalists are invited to an interview with the Michel David-Weill Scholarship Selection Committee. Non-finalists are also contacted at this time.	January/February
Finalists are interviewed in New York by the Michel David-Weill Scholarship Selection Committee. The scholarship laureate is contacted, as are other finalists.	February/March
