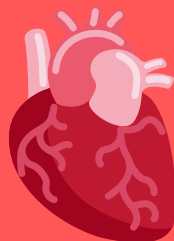

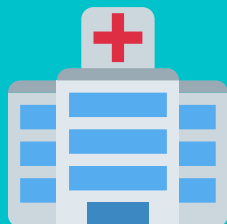

- Knowledge on how to read and interpret blood work, echocardiograms, ECG's, and cardiac MRI's

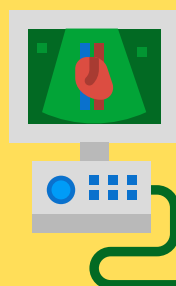
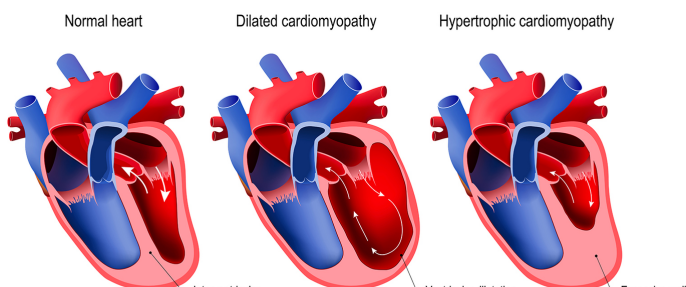


TASKS ACCOMPLISHED
